It must be filled in to cover the military status, as of the date it is filed, of all known defendants.

*In the body of the affidavit it should be stated that none of the defendants served by certified/registered mail
(or deputy sheriff) are in the military service, if such be the fact.

The last printed allegation should not be stricken from the affidavit under any circumstances because it covers
interests not of record.
